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Crestview Elementary

- Based on October 1, 2018 data, Minnesota Department of Education flagged Crestview Elementary as a Racially Identifiable School.



Racially Identifiable School:

- A school where the percent of protected students in a school is more than 20 percentage points above the protected students in the entire district for the grade levels served by that school.

~Minn. Rule 3535.0110

Protected Class:

- African/Black Americans, Asian/Pacific Americans, Chicano/Latino Americans, American Indian/Alaskan Natives, and multi-racial.
