Pullman Elementary has made targeted efforts to personalize instruction for our students and to keep parents informed throughout the year. Mentoring programs, community outreach, student leadership and family events are a few of the ways we have made connections with our school and the community. Staff regularly meet to discuss progress and develop ways to make our school environment a welcoming and open place for all students and families.

Woodbury High School has incorporated several intentional efforts to develop and further enhance individual relationships with students. We have distributed Good News Cards for the past 4 years with increased focus each successive year. We have also implemented intentional time during each staff meeting to reflect and plan points of contact with students. Staff are currently engaged in creating a teacher developed progress monitoring system for students, with ideas to implement and move forward with a school-wide model per our district Strategic Plan.
